Action: Review and extend the Camden Climate Fund to provide financial support for energy efficiency improvement and renewable energy and heat deployment, with a focus on the fuel poor and community groups. Panel task: How could we incentivise residents to retrofit their homes?</p> <p><i>Group 2 – Organisations</i></p> <p>Key challenge: reducing scope 1,2&3 emissions of organisations. Action: Through the Camden Climate Change Alliance, develop a Zero Carbon pledge for local organisations. Panel ask: How can the panel help to increase sign-ups and support community engagement?</p>
